- My HR: Everything you need to know about your role here at KP. This is a key resource no matter your length of time at KP. You can access this important resource online <u>https://epf.kp.org/wps/portal/hr/home</u> at work or from home by simply using your NUID number. You can also contact our National HR Service Center at 1-877-457-4772, Monday–Friday, 8 a.m.–7 p.m. The best times to call for non-urgent issues is Tuesday–Thursday, 8–9 a.m., and 6–7 p.m.
 - Once you've signed on to My HR, don't forget to check out the <u>long list of employee discounts</u> available to KPCO employees. Discounts are available for cars, cellphones, child care, computers & internet, dining, entertainment, financial, health & fitness, housing, and travel, among others. You can even check out discounts available to KP employees in other regions.
- **Rewards and Recognition:** Being recognized for the work you do is important for creating a warm, welcoming workplace culture. You can help support our KP culture by sending a virtual pat-on-the-back to a deserving colleague at https://kaiser.rewardsnation.com/logon.asp. Other recognition resources include:
 - Nominate a co-worker who's a true service superstar. Our <u>Legendary Service P.R.I.D.E. Award</u> (which includes a \$250 reward) singles out up to two health plan employees, one CPMG physician, and one ATM each quarter who consistently demonstrate outstanding service, accountability, and responsiveness toward members and/or their fellow co-workers.
 - Our annual <u>Summit Award</u> is the highest honor given to individual KPCO employees each spring. The awards are presented to one individual in each of our four employee groups — Local 105, Local 7, Nonrepresented Individual Contributor, and Non-represented Management — and are selected solely by their peers.
 - Our <u>CARE Program</u> recognizes the creation and implementation of innovative, resourceful ideas by individual employees and work groups that result in business operating efficiencies. Employees can even receive monetary rewards depending on the level of involvement and originality of the successfully implemented idea. Projects can be completed and submitted for consideration anytime during the year.
